When we launch a new version of Phoniro Care, any of our apps, and/or software for our alarm servers, it is called a release. These new versions we collect into a release package. Sometimes there are several new versions (releases) in one release package but other times there is only one new version included.

Improvements in Battery Reporting

We continuously work to improve how Phoniro Care and our lock batteries exchange information. This data forms the basis for the reports and alerts you see in Phoniro Care. When we make improvements, it leads to fewer alerts and longer intervals between battery replacements. In this release, we've made improvements in the following areas:

- More information about the battery and Phoniro Care is written into the log file
- When the battery level reaches "warning" or "critical," this is recorded in the log file
- Outdated reporting methods between the app and Phoniro Care have been removed
- Battery status starts being reported only once the battery is installed at the care recipient/location, providing more reliable status
- Adjusted thresholds for when alerts are sent for batteries installed in Phoniro Lock 390, resulting in longer intervals between battery replacements in these lock devices
